

Downtown Walgreens moves forward

With some conditions, city officials have given the green light to the planned demolition of three buildings in downtown Yakima for construction of a new Walgreens store.

A developer for the drugstore chain got the go-ahead Tuesday for the planned construction of a 13,680-square-foot store at the corner of West Yakima and Seventh avenues on the western edge of the downtown business district.

Before it can build, Walgreens wants to demolish three existing buildings on its new property, now occupied by Instant Press, Sullivan's Dry Cleaners and Cascade Shade.
